The Rules Review Commission staff has completed its review of this rule prior to the Commission's next meeting. The Commission has not yet reviewed this rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the rule will be approved. In reviewing these rules, the staff determined that the following technical changes need to be made. Approval of any rule is contingent upon making technical changes as set forth in G.S. 150B-21.10.

Line 5, add a comma after "Lake"

Line 21, to be consistent with the other Paragraphs, it appears as though there should be a hyphen between "B" and "An" Use a lowercase "a" for "An" to be consistent.

Line 31, please correct the length of the hyphen.

Page 2, line 1, what is meant by "board of Commissioners"? Can this be clarified? In 15A NCAC 10F .0355, a specific county of commissioners is identified.

Page 2, line 8, correct the effective date to January 1, 2015.

(c) Placement and Maintenance of Markers. Each of the boards of Commissioners of the above-named counties is
designated a suitable agency for placement and maintenance of markers implementing this Rule for regulated areas
within their territorial jurisdiction in accordance with the Uniform System.
