REQUEST FOR TECHNICAL CHANGE

The Rules Review Commission staff has completed its review of this rule prior to the Commission's next meeting. The Commission has not yet reviewed this rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the rule will be approved. You may call this office to inquire concerning the staff recommendation.

In reviewing these rules, the staff determined that the following technical changes need to be made:

In (a), I think the language should read "to be pests"

In (b), line 7, what is "managed turf"? I take it your regulated public knows?

In (b)(7), line 14, what is a "visitors center"? I take it your regulated public knows?

In (c), line 15, replace "regulation" with "Rule"

In (d), generally "but not limited to" is not included in Rule language. Do you feel you need to retain this?

Also in (d), I take it your regulated public knows what the terms "streams, rivers, ponds, swamps, lakes, and wetlands" mean?

1 02 NCAC 09L .0707 is proposed for adoption as published in 29:08 NCR 906 as follows: 2 3 EASTERN AND HAIRY-TAILED MOLES 02 NCAC 09L .0707 4 (a) The North Carolina Pesticide Board hereby declares the eastern mole, Scalpus aquaticus, and the hairy-tailed mole, Parascalops breweri, to be pest as provided by law. 5 6 (b) Pesticides registered for use to control the eastern mole and the hairy-tailed mole may be used when either species is 7 tunneling in managed turf in the following areas: 8 (1) residential; 9 (2) commercial; (3) 10 government property, excluding federal and state parks; 11 (4) golf courses, driving ranges, and golf instructional facilities; 12 (5) sod farms; 13 (6) athletic fields; or 14 visitor centers and cemeteries. (7) 15 (c) For purposes of this regulation, managed turf shall not include pastures. (d) Pesticides used to control the eastern mole and the hairy-tailed mole shall not be applied within 100 feet of natural or 16 17 man-made bodies of water, including but not limited to, streams, rivers, ponds, swamps, lakes, and wetlands. 18 (e) Pesticides used to control the eastern mole and the hairy-tailed mole shall not be applied at elevations of 4000 feet or 19 greater. 20 21 History Note: Authority G.S. 143-444(1); 143-458 22 Eff.
