What is the purpose of (a)?

In (b), you say the written address must be addressed to the Board. Do you have another Rule you can cite to with the Board's contact information or could you add that here?

I suggest that you begin (b)(1) through (4) and (c)(1) though (3) with lowercase letters.

In (b)(2) and (3), the statute allows for declaratory rulings for orders, as well.

In (b)(3), the request can also be for validity of the rule. Other agencies have said language such as, " a concise statement as to whether the request is for a ruling on the validity of a rule or on the applicability of a statute, rule, or order to a given factual situation;" You may wish to use similar language to capture everything governed by the statute.

In (c)(1), who will make the determination for "substantially similar" facts?

In (c)(3), is this if the Board is a party? If not, how will the Board know about it?

In (c), rearrange the sentence to state, "the Board shall make a decision to grant or deny the petition based upon a study..."

And what is meant on line 15 by "any other relevant information"? As determined by whom, the Board?
