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9B. Explain: The NC Wildlife Resources Commission (WRC) revised the training requirements for the NC Wildlife Enforcement Officers. As opposed to requiring the Basic Law Enforcement Training - Wildlife Law Enforcement Officers program, the WRC is now requiring the Basic Law Enforcement Training (BLET) program, which is required for all sworn law enforcement officers in order to obtain certification. The WRC made these revisions in order to make the training consistent with other law enforcement agencies throughout the State, limit any potential liability claims due to inconsistent training; include beneficial training topics that are not part of the Wildlife basic Training program, but are included in the BLET, and facilitate the more efficient hiring of officers transferring from other law enforcement agencies.
