These rule Changes (Title 21 Chapter 19) will affect all Licensed Electrologist and Licensed Laser Hair Practitioners, but mostly targets the Laser Hair Practitioners.

0701 (a) It is difficult to get 75% in a specific topic of practice. Not much changes in a year on modalities. Many other subjects are just as important, such as business management, safety in the workplace, disease prevention, skin problems, etc.

0701 (f) CEUs should be allowed to carry over regardless of how they are obtained, if they were previously approved by the Board. (At least 1.0 CEUs or 10 hours)

0702 (b) State organizations should be allowed to offer CEUs ! This targets groups that do not wish to be affiliated with a National Organization due to the high membership fee

and our reluctance to have requirements imposed on us.

0702 (c) Board should be required to respond their approval or disapproval in a timely manner. Often, it is too late to apply for classes before they approve.
