The Coastal Resources Commission (CRC) is proposing to repeal the High Hazard Flood AEC, which is identified as the Velocity Zones on Flood Insurance Rate Maps administered by the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). Changes to the NFIP and to the NC Building Code parallel the CRC requirements for construction in these areas.
