15	(b) For enforcement purposes, Nothing nothing in this Rule is intended to supersede existing occupational safety and
16	health standards and federal regulations adopted and enforced by the North Carolina Department of Labor, including
17	<u>Labor or</u> state-specific rules codified in the North Carolina Administrative Code.
18	(c) Where the NIOSH recommendations are inconsistent with State or federal laws, regulations, or rules, compliance
19	with the State or federal law, regulation, or rule shall be accepted in lieu of compliance with the NIOSH
20	recommendations.
