Line 8 uses the term "application" twice. Consider the following re-write:

"same application and required documents, and the examination fees,"

Line 12, the citation to Rule .0206 seems incorrect as that rule was repealed in 2011. Please check citations.

Line 17, specify the statute. It may be G.S. 90-202.8.

Line 18, specify the "other legal document"

4	(a) A podiatrist whose license renewal has been delinquent for six months following the July 1 deadline of the
5	end of the podiatrist's last renewal period and cancelled shall re-apply for a new examination. Application
6	shall be made in accordance with the statute and the following:
7	(1) re-apply to the Board for licensure as if he or she is a first-time applicant, including the same
8	application, required documents, and application and examination fees, pursuant to 21 NCAC 52
9	<u>.0201, .0601, and .0613;</u>
10	(2) appear before the Board at the same time and in the same place as other license examinees and
11	take the same examination as a first-time applicant, including the practice and ethics examination
12	pursuant to 21 NCAC 52. 0202, .0205, and .0206; and
13	(3) receive a passing grade in all parts of the Board licensing examination and pay the license
14	certificate fee pursuant to 21 NCAC 52.0613 before being issued a new license certificate and
15	<u>license number.</u>
16	(b) A podiatrist whose license has been suspended, put on probation, or has invoked any other form of
17	temporary censure due to disciplinary action in accordance with the statute shall follow the instructions
18	related to reinstatement contained in the specific consent order or other legal document setting forth the
19	provisions of the sanction.
