in accordance with the statute and the following:

- 7 (1) re-apply to the Board for licensure as if he or she is a first-time applicant, including the same
 8 application, required documents, and application and examination fees, pursuant to Rule .0201 of
 9 this Section and Rules. 0601 and .0613 of this Chapter;
- appear before the Board at the same time and in the same place as other license examinees and
 take the same examination as a first-time applicant, including the practice and ethics examination
 pursuant to Rules 0202, .0205, and .0206 of this Chapter; and
- (3) receive a passing grade in all parts of the Board licensing examination and pay the license
 certificate fee pursuant to Rule .0613 of this Chapter before being issued a new license certificate
 and license number.

(b) A podiatrist whose license has been suspended, put on probation, or has invoked any other form of temporary
 censure due to disciplinary action in accordance with the statute <u>G.S. 90-202.8</u> shall follow the instructions related
 to reinstatement contained in the specific consent order or other legal document setting forth the provisions of the

- sanction.
