

1 21 NCAC 52 .0215 is adopted with changes as published in 29:24 NCR 2805 as follows:

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3 **21 NCAC 52 .0215 LICENSE RE-INSTATEMENT**

4 (a) A podiatrist whose license renewal has been delinquent for six months following the July 1 deadline of the end  
5 of the podiatrist's last renewal period ~~and cancelled~~ shall re-apply for a new examination. Application shall be made  
6 in accordance with the statute and the following:

7 (1) re-apply to the Board for licensure as if he or she is a first-time applicant, including the same  
8 application, required documents, and application and examination fees, pursuant to Rule .0201 of  
9 this Section and Rules .0601 and .0613 of this Chapter;

10 (2) appear before the Board at the same time and in the same place as other license examinees and  
11 take the same examination as a first-time applicant, including the practice and ethics examination  
12 pursuant to Rules 0202, .0205, and .0206 of this Chapter; and

13 (3) receive a passing grade in all parts of the Board licensing examination and pay the license  
14 certificate fee pursuant to Rule .0613 of this Chapter before being issued a new license certificate  
15 and license number.

16 (b) A podiatrist whose license has been suspended, put on probation, or has invoked any other form of temporary  
17 censure due to disciplinary action in accordance with ~~the statute~~ G.S. 90-202.8 shall follow the instructions related  
18 to reinstatement contained in the specific consent order ~~or other legal document~~ setting forth the provisions of the  
19 sanction.

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3 **21 NCAC 52 .0611 FORMS AND APPLICATIONS**

4 (a) The Board shall issue the following items in accordance with applicable state statutes and this Chapter's  
5 administrative rules:

- 6 (1) Certificate of Licensure;
- 7 (2) Licensure Renewal Card;
- 8 (3) Temporary License Certificate; and
- 9 (4) Certificate of Corporate Registration.

10 (b) The Board shall provide and require use of the following application forms that may be obtained from the  
11 Board's web site, <http://www.ncbpe.org>:

- 12 (1) Licensure Renewal Application;
- 13 (2) Disclaimer Form;
- 14 (3) Corporate Registration Application;
- 15 (4) Corporate Registration Renewal;
- 16 (5) Specialty Credentialing Application; ~~and~~
- 17 (6) CME (Continuing Medical Education) Submission Form-Form;
- 18 (7) Recommendation Form; and
- 19 (8) License Application (Regular, Temporary, Military, Reciprocity).
