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12	by reference. (c) The following definitions shall be substituted for "Facility" and "Transfer Facility": The following definition shall be		
13	substituted for "Contained":		
14	(1) "Facility" means:		
15	(A) All contiguous land, structures, other appurtenances, and improvements on the land, used for		
16	treating, storing, or disposing of hazardous waste. A facility may consist of several		
17	treatment, storage, or disposal operational units (e.g., one or more landfills, surface		
18	impoundments, or combinations of them).		
19	(B) For the purpose of implementing corrective action under 40 CFR 264.101, all contiguous		
20	property under the control of the owner or operator seeking a permit under Subtitle C of		
21	RCRA. This definition also applies to facilities implementing corrective action under RCRA		
22	Section 3008(h).		
23	(C) Notwithstanding Part (B) of this definition, a remediation waste management site is not a		
24	facility that is subject to 40 CFR 264.101, but is subject to corrective action requirements if		
25	the site is located within such a facility.		
26	(2) "Transfer facility" means any transportation related facility including loading docks, parking areas,		
27	storage areas and other similar areas where shipments of hazardous waste are held during the normal		
28	course of transportation.		
29	"Contained" means held in a unit (including a land-based unit as defined in this subpart) that meets the		
30	following criteria:		
31	[(A)](1) The unit is in good condition, with no leaks or other continuing or intermittent unpermitted		
32	releases of the hazardous secondary materials or hazardous constituents originating from the		
33	hazardous secondary materials to the environment, and is designed, as appropriate for the		
34	hazardous secondary materials, to prevent releases of hazardous secondary materials to the		
35	environment. Unpermitted releases are releases that are not covered by a permit (such as a		
36	permit to discharge to water or air) and may include, but are not limited to, releases through		
37	surface transport by precipitation		

I		runoff, releases to soil and groundwater, windblown dust, fugitive air emissions, and	
2		catastrophic unit failures;	
3	[(I	3) (2) The unit is properly labeled or otherwise has a system (such as a log) to immediately identify	
4		the hazardous secondary materials in the unit; and	
5	[(C	The unit holds hazardous secondary materials that are compatible with other hazardous	
6		secondary materials placed in the unit and is compatible with the materials used to construct	
7		the unit and addresses any potential risks of fires or explosions.	
8	[(I	Hazardous secondary materials in units that meet the applicable requirements of 40 CFR	
9		parts 264 or 265 are presumptively contained.	
10	(d) The following additional definitions shall apply throughout this Subchapter:		
11	(1) "So	ection" means the Hazardous Waste Section, in the Division of Waste Management, Department of	
12	En	wironment and Natural Resources Environmental Quality.	
13	(2) Th	ne "Department" means the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR)	
14	<u>En</u>	vironmental Quality (DEQ).	
15	(3) "D	vivision" means the Division of Waste Management (DWM).	
16	(4) "L	ong Term Storage" means the containment of hazardous waste for an indefinite period of time in a	
17	fac	cility designed to be closed with the hazardous waste in place.	
18	(5) "O	off-site Recycling Facility" means any facility that receives shipments of hazardous waste from	
19	off	f-site to be recycled or processed for recycling through any process conducted at the facility, but	
20	do	es not include any facility owned or operated by a generator of hazardous waste solely to	
21	rec	cycle their own waste.
