The Rules Review Commission staff has completed its review of this rule prior to the Commission's next meeting. The Commission has not yet reviewed this rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the rule will be approved. In reviewing these rules, the staff determined that the following technical changes need to be made. Approval of any rule is contingent upon making technical changes as set forth in G.S. 150B-21.10.

Line 3, add an "N" before "CAC"

Line 9, place the term "Notification" in quotation marks to clarify that the term is being defined.

Line 13 and 17, clarify what is meant by the term "alternate" Is this a person or an address?

Line 20, clarify what qualifies as "instant messaging"

Line 20, add a period after "messaging"

Line 23, replace "will" with "shall"

Line 27, consider adding "143-443(b)(4)" to the authority

Line 29, add the amended effective date of "January 1, 2016." to the history note and reflect that addition on line 28.
