Most of the rules were created and became effective in 1983. Very few of the rules have been amended or added, with the last change in 2000. The rules have never undergone a thorough review for accuracy and alignment with policy and practice.	
Rationale: The majority of amendments and repeals for 71P are intended to:

17 NCAC 07B .1201, TAXABILITY OF GROSS RECEIPTS

9A. Cite Session Law: S.L. 2014-3, s. 8.1.(a), 8.1.(b), and 8.1.(c)

9B. Explain: Effective June 1, 2014, S.L. 2014-3, s. 8.1.(a), 8.1.(b), and 8.1.(c) adds G.S. 105-164.4F, which codifies the NC Department of Revenue’s historical position concerning accommodation rentals that had been set forth in the rule. The rule duplicates what is now provided by statute.

17 NCAC 07B .1401, PRESCRIPTION DRUGS

9A. Cite Session Law: N/A

9B. Explain: The term “prescription drugs” is not defined in the taxing statutes. G.S. 105-164.13(13)(a) allows a specific exemption from sales and use tax of “[d]rugs required by federal law to be dispensed only on prescription.” Therefore, the rule is inaccurate.

17 NCAC 07B .2208, FRATERNITY AND SORORITY MEALS

17 NCAC 07B .2608, PLUMBING: HEATING CONTRACTORS: PURCHASES

9A. Cite Session Law: S.L. 2014-3, s. 7.1.(a) and s. 7.1.(b)

9B. Explain: S.L. 2014-3, s. 7.1.(a) defines the term “real property contractor” under G.S. 105-164.3. S.L. 2014-3, s. 7.1(b) adds G.S. 105-164.4(a)(13) to impose sales and use tax on tangible personal property sold to a real property contractor. These sales are taxed in accordance with G.S. 105-164.4H that is effective January 1, 2015 and applies to sales on or after that date and contracts entered into on or after that date.

17 NCAC 07B .4407, LEASES FOR OUT OF STATE USE

9A. Cite Session Law: S.L. 2003-284, s. 45.3

9B. Explain: Effective July 15, 2003, S.L. 2003-284, s. 45.3 amended G.S. 105-164.4B, to add sourcing principles for periodic rental payments for leases and rentals of specific categories of tangible personal property. The rule is a duplication of this statute.
