1 21 NCAC 33 .0110 is adopted with changes as published in NCR 30:13, page 1406-1407, as follows: 2 3 21 NCAC 33 .0110 **REPORTING CRITERIA** 4 (a) The Department of Health and Human Services ("Department") may report to the North Carolina 5 Midwifery Joint Committee ("MJC") Committee information regarding the prescribing practices of those 6 Certified Nurse Midwives midwives ("prescribers") whose prescribing: 7 falls within the top one percent of those prescribing 100 milligrams of morphine (1) 8 equivalents ("MME") per patient per day; or 9 (2) falls within the top one percent of those prescribing 100 MME's per patient per day in 10 combination with any benzodiazepine and who are within the top one percent of all 11 controlled substance prescibers by volume. 12 (b) In addition, the Department may report to the MJC Committee information regarding prescribers 13 midwives who have had two or more patient deaths in the preceding 12 months due to opioid poisoning. 14 (c) The Department may submit these reports to the MJC Committee upon request and may include the 15 information described in G.S. 90-113.73(b). 16 (d) The reports and communications between the Department and the MJC Committee shall remain 17 confidential pursuant to G.S. 90-113.74. 18 19 History Note: Authority G.S. 90-113.74; 20 Eff.
