

9B. Explain: NC entered into an agreement on 8/1/64 with the US Atomic Energy Commission, currently the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). The agreement provided for the discontinuance of the Commission's regulatory authority and responsibility in NC as long as the Commission determined NC's program for radiation protection was compatible with federal regulations and was adequate to protect public health and safety. The agreement requires NC to maintain compatibility with federal NRC radiation protection rules and failure could result in NC losing its Agreement State status. The federal regulations for security practices for entities that use radioactive materials for category 1 and category 2 sources of radiation were recently revised in 10 CFR 37. This rule adoption is compatible with these revised federal regulations and is necessary to ensure the safety of NC citizens and for NC to remain an Agreement State with the NRC.
