I am writing to you pursuant to 26 NCAC 05 .0204 to request an extension of time within which to file the Periodic Review of Existing Rules Report for the submission to the Rules Review Commission for the Division of Social Services (DSS). The DSS is hereby requesting an extension of time from the Commission based on the following:
