The Name contained in Box 2 of the Submission for Permanent Rule Form does not match the name of the Rule. Please correct where appropriate.

In Subparagraph (a)(1), do you mean that the area designated is to be considered the recreational area? If so, please consider making this more clear. Also, please remove the capitalization of "Area."

In Subparagraph (a)(3), by the "unnamed canal" do you mean that which is located at 36.22508N, 76.70787W.? If so, this is fine as written, I just wanted to verify.

In (b), please change "Subparagraph (1) of Paragraph (a)" to "Subparagraph (a)(1)"

In (c), please change "Subparagraph (1) of Paragraph (a)" to "Subparagraph (a)(1)"

In (c), line 16, please change "the proper marking of the area" to "mark the area." Otherwise, please define "proper."

In (d), please change "Subparagraph (2) and (3) of Paragraph (a) to "Subparagraphs (a)(2) and (3)."

Please review the language in (e) to determine what is necessary. In looking at similar rules to this, the last sentence has not been included in recent editions. Please revise for purposes of clarity.

Please retype the rule accordingly and resubmit it to our office at 1711 New Hope Church Road, Raleigh, North Carolina 27609.
