The Rules Review Commission staff has completed its review of this rule prior to the Commission's next meeting. The Commission has not yet reviewed this rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the rule will be approved. You may call this office to inquire concerning the staff recommendation.

In reviewing these rules, the staff determined that the following technical changes need to be made:

In Paragraph (a), you refer to "non-collusion certification" on lines 6 and 8. When you use the term in (b), line 11, and (c), line 19, it's capitalized and in quotation marks. Is there a reason for this?

In (b), line 11, please set off the website with commas.

In (b)(2), line 16, please state "G.S. 133-24" rather than what you have. As you published it correctly, you do not need to show it as a change; simply do so.

It appears that (b)(3) repeats the statement of lines 8-10. Do you need it both places? If you don't, I recommend removing it from (a) and retaining in it in (b)(3).

On line 19, please insert the line under "(c)" Since it was published that way, you do not need to show it as a change, but simply insert the line.

In (c), line 20, what is "debarment status"? Does your regulated public know?

On line 23, what are the guidelines the Department will use to make the determination?

In the History Note, please put the citations in numerical order.

5	(a) Every bidder and subcontractor shall furnish to the Department an unsworn certification made under penalty of	
6	perjury under the laws of the United States, a non-collusion affidavits certification at the time of bid, certifying that	
7	the bidder has not entered into any agreement, participated in any collusion, or otherwise taken any action in	
8	restraint of free competitive bidding in connection with his <u>or her</u> bid on the project. The <u>affidavit non-collusion</u>	
9	$\underline{\text{certification}} \text{ shall also indicate that the bidder intends to do the work with its own employees or subcontractors and}$	
10	is not bidding for the benefit of another contractor.	
11	(b) A "Non-Collusion Certification" form means a form provided on the Department's website www.ncdot.gov for	
12	execution by the bidding prequalified contractor certifying that:	
13	(1) neither the individual, nor any official, agent, or employee has entered into any agreement, participated	
14	in any collusion, or otherwise taken any action that is in restraint of free competitive bidding in connection	
15	with any bid or contract;	
16	(2) the bidder has not been convicted of violating N.C.G.S § 133-24 within the last three years; and	
17	(3) the bidder intends to do the work with its own employees or subcontractors and the bid is not for the	
18	benefit of another contractor.	
19	(b) (c) In the "Non-Collusion Certification" form, the prospective bidder and subcontractors shall also certify his or	
20	her debarment status under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States. furnish executed debarment	
21	eertification forms to the Department. In the event the prospective bidder or subcontractor cannot certify that he or	
22	she is not disbarred, the prospective bidder or subcontractor shall provide a written explanation, which the	
23	Department shall review and evaluate to determine if the bidder or subcontractor is still prequalified for bidding,	
24	eontracting contracting. or subcontracting on Department projects.
