

The federal citations are 12 C.F.R. Part 723 and 12 C.F.R. Part 741.3 State chartered credit unions would have been disadvantaged without approval of the temporary rule and would therefore be disadvantaged if we do not continue with 04 NCAC 06C .0407 as written. We have a modification in the rule that requires credit unions \$250,000,000 and smaller to get policies reviewed by the Administrator of Credit Unions prior to initiating a loan program.
