

9B. Explain: Computed Tomography (CT) delivers high quality imaging with significant benefits to patients. This rule ensures CT imaging encompasses recommendations of the American College of Radiology (ACR) and is compatible with the Food and Drug Administration's federal regulations in 21 CFR. The rules in 10A NCAC 15 are not specific to the use of CT equipment making it difficult to determine which rules apply for registrants and regulators. Problems identified with CT scans have been a lack of quality assurance (QA) and/or a lack of administrative controls. The rule implements QA and training requirements, already being used by many NC facilities and simplifies compliance with regulations. The rule reduces the hazards associated with the use of CT x-ray machines whether the facility is accredited or not.
