3	14B NCAC 15C .0505 OFF-SITE STORAGE LOCATION
4	(a) The holder of a brewery, winery, or distillery permit shall notify the Commission in advance of storing any
5	alcoholic beverages that the permittee manufactures under its permit in a noncontiguous storage location as authorized
6	pursuant to G.S. 18B-1120. This notification shall be deemed a part of the original permit application.
7	(b) Notification shall be made on a form approved by the Commission that requires:
8	(1) the permittee's name,name:
9	(2) address, the business mailing address;
10	(3) the permit number, number;
11	(4) the principal location address; address;
12	(5) the noncontiguous storage location address, address;
13	(6) a detailed diagram of the premises showing the exact locations of entrances, exits, storage areas for
14	alcoholic beverages, and separate storage areas for any other property or merchandise, and
15	merchandise;
16	(7) a copy of the Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau approval of the noncontiguous storag
17	location and location; and
18	(8) a copy of the Commission's Inspection/Zoning Zoning and Compliance form, form applicable to
19	the noncontiguous storage location, completed pursuant to G.S. 18B 901(c), applicable to the
20	noncontiguous storage location. G.S. 18B-901(c).
21	(b)(c) The noncontiguous storage location shall only be used by the permittee for storage of alcoholic beverage
22	manufactured by the permittee and non-alcoholic items owned by the permittee. No alcoholic beverages of the
23	permittee shall be stored in the same storage area with other property or merchandise of the permittee or any other
24	person. The noncontiguous storage location shall be subject to inspection pursuant to G.S. 18B-502 and Rule .050
25	of this Section.
