Pursuant to this action by the Board of Trustees, the Retirement Systems Division (the "Division") has been administering the CBBC law since January 1, 2015. Litigation is currently pending by four local school boards against the Teachers' and State Employees' Retirement System (TSERS) Board of Trustees who also adopted a cap factor effective in 2016 pursuant to the CBBC law. On May 30, 2017, on petition of four school systems, a Wake County Superior Court judge ruled that adoption of the contribution-based cap factor requires rulemaking		
under the Administrative Procedure Act; this ruling has been appealed. The LGERS Board strongly disagrees with the ruling by the Superior Court; however, out of an abundance of caution, the System has decided to engage in rulemaking on the topic in the unlikely event that the four school systems prevail on appeal. The TSERS Board of Trustees is undergoing similar rulemaking.
