FORESTERS, BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR

North Carolina forbids the use of the title "Forester," "registered forester," or any other descriptive term including those terms unless the person is registered under this act. It does not forbid the practice of forestry or anything that can be done by a registered forester. Forester means a person who by reason of special knowledge and training is qualified to engage in the practice of forestry, which is defined as giving professional forestry services, including consultation, investigation, evaluation, education, planning, or responsible supervision of any forestry activities requiring knowledge, training, and experience in forestry principles and techniques.
