Re: 2012 Fuel Gas Code – 311, 2012 Mechanical Code – 313, 2012 Plumbing Code – 315, 2009 Residential Code – 313.1, 2012 Residential Code – 315

Dear Mr. Gupton:

At its November 17, 2011 meeting the Rules Review Commission objected to the above-captioned rules in accordance with G.S. 150B-21.10.

The Commission objected to these rules based on lack of authority. There is no authority to require carbon monoxide alarms in all the new construction and existing dwellings covered by this rule. The scope or coverage of this rule is too broad. The statutory authority extends to only a "dwellings unit having a fossil-fuel burning heater, appliance, or fireplace, and in any dwelling unit having an attached garage" (G.S. 143-138(b2)). These two rules appear to extend that requirement to all dwellings covered under this portion of the building code, including those who do not have either a fossil-fuel burning heater, appliance, fireplace or an attached garage.

Please respond to this letter in accordance with the provisions of G.S. 150B-21.12. If you have any questions regarding the Commission's action, please let me know.
