At its November 15, 2012 meeting the Rules Review Commission objected to the above-captioned rules in accordance with G.S. 150B-21.10.

The Commission objected to Rule .0201 based on lack of statutory authority. There is no authority cited for the requirement that a contractor with a ["valid"] claim against the Department of Transportation (DOT) for any amount he claims is due to "exhaust whatever informal negotiation steps the Chief Engineer has established" before resorting to any other options allowed him by law.
