At its March 21, 2013 meeting the Rules Review Commission extended the period of review on the above-captioned rules in accordance with G.S. 150B-21.13.

The Commission extended the period of review because it believes that the language in (e)(2), "similar arrangement," should be worded more clearly to indicate the precise nature of the arrangement that will not be allowed. At the meeting, the Board's attorney indicated it would provide that clarification by adding language to the rule to clarify the regulatory intent.

3	11 NCAC 08.	.1116 CODE OF ETHICS
4	(a) Licensees	shall discharge their duties with fidelity to the public, their clients, and public and to their clients, with
5	fairness and impartiality to all.	
6	(b) Opinions expressed by licensees shall only be based only on their education, experience, and honest convictions.	
7	(c) A licensee shall not disclose any information about the results of an inspection without the approval of the client for	
8	whom the inspection was performed, or the client's designated representative.	
9	(d) No licensee shall accept compensation or any other consideration from more than one interested party for the same	
10	service without the consent of all interested parties.	
11	(e) No licensee shall accept or offer commissions or allowances, directly or indirectly, from other parties dealing with	
12	the client in connection with work for which the licensee is responsible. No licensee shall directly or indirectly	
13	compensate compensate, either financially or through other services or benefits, realty agents, agents or other parties	
14	having with a financial interest in closing or settlement of real estate transactions, transactions for the following: referral	
15	(1) Referral of inspections inspections; or for inclusion	
16	(2) Inclusion on a list of recommended inspectors, preferred providers, or a similar arrangements. arrangement.	
17	(f) No licensee shall express, within the context of an inspection, an appraisal or opinion of the market value of the	
18	inspected property.	
19	(g) Before the execution of a contract to perform a home inspection, a licensee shall disclose to the client any interest he	
20	or she has in a business that may affect the client. No licensee shall allow his or her interest in any business to affect the	
21	quality or results of the inspection work that the licensee may be called upon to perform.	
22	(h) A licensee shall not solicit for repairs of systems or components found defective in the course of a home inspection	
23	performed by the licensee or that licensee's company.	
24	(i) Licensees shall not engage in false or misleading advertising or otherwise misrepresent any matters to the public.	
25	(j) Licensees shall not inspect properties under contingent arrangements whereby any compensation or future referrals	
26	are dependent on reported findings or on the sale of a property.
