In reviewing this Rule, the staff recommends the following technical changes be made:

In (a), line 4, consider stating "A written petition requesting rulemaking shall be sent to the Executive Director of the Wildlife Resources Commission,"

And just so I am clear, you only accept mailed petitions and not those that are sent electronically? If so, that's fine, but I did want to check.

Consider beginning (a)(1) through (5) with articles, like "the"

In (a)(2), line 8, insert a comma after "group"

In (a)(3), line 10, what do you mean by "identification"? A rule number?

Also on line 10. insert a comma after "amended"

In (b), line 15, insert a comma after "photographs"

On line 16, replace "which" with "that"
