Please accept this letter as my personal objection to the request of the NC State Board of Elections to change the rules (08 NCAC 04 .0308) surrounding election data, ballot and records access. I contend that the public needs and deserves access to any data surrounding any election in order to independently verify any and all elections results through any means necessary and within reasonable periods of time following elections. The proposed rule changes will unreasonably restrict public access to records that support the veracity and validity of elections.
