Explain: On October 3, 2023, the General Assembly enacted S.L. 2023-133, which required the State Board of Education to adopt new rules governing interscholastic athletics conducted by public school units. These rules addressed a variety of topics related to athletics, including administration of interscholastic athletics by administering organizations and public school units, student health and safety, student participation (eligibility) requirements, amateur rules, penalties, limitations on recruiting and undue influence, and appealing decisions related to the enforcement of these rules to an independent appeals board. In compliance with that legislation, the SBE adopted temporary rules for the 2024-2025 school year, codified in Title 16, Subchapter 06E, Section .0200 of the North Carolina Administrative Code. The SBE has now adopted permanent rules to replace the temporary rules, which will apply beginning with the 2025-2026 school year. The permanent rules include amendments to two existing rules and the adoption of eight new rules. In addition to the subject matter covered by the temporary rules, the proposed permanent rules also include regulations related to Name, Image, and Likeness ("NIL").

These rules addressed a variety of topics related to athletics, including administration of interscholastic athletics by administering organizations and public school units, student health and safety, student participation (eligibility) requirements, amateur rules, penalties, limitations on recruiting and undue influence, and appealing decisions related to the enforcement of these rules to an independent appeals board. In compliance with that legislation, the SBE adopted temporary rules for the 2024-2025 school year, codified in Title 16, Subchapter 06E, Section .0200 of the North Carolina Administrative Code. The SBE has now adopted permanent rules to replace the temporary rules, which will apply beginning with the 2025-2026 school year. The permanent rules include amendments to two existing rules and the adoption of eight new rules. In addition to the subject matter covered by the temporary rules, the proposed permanent rules also include regulations related to Name, Image, and Likeness ("NIL").



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
