<b>9B. Explain:</b> Session Law 2021-3, Section 2.9.(a), permits "i acting injectable medications to adults pursuant to prescription of the section of the sectio	mmunizing pharmacists" (as defined by statute) to administer long- on. The law became effective on October 1, 2021, and the Board of
Pharmacy adopted a temporary rule (21 NCAC 46.2514) to implement the section, as permitted by the statute. Because of the placement of the long-acting injectable authority in the "immunizing pharmacist" statute (90-85.15B), a permanent rule governing the administration of these drugs was required to be approved by both the Board of Pharmacy and the Medical Board. The Board of Pharmacy proposed adoption of a permanent version of Rule .2514. The proposed rule put appropriate standards in place for training, recordkeeping and other requirements needed to ensure that the drugs are administered with adequate protection of the public health, safety, and welfare (NC Register, Volume 36, Issue 16, pages 1393). After successfully completing the rulemaking process, amended rule 21 NCAC 46 .2507 and permanent rule 21 NCAC 46 .2514 became effective July 1, 2022. The Board of Nursing Administrative Code 21 NCAC 36 .0221 (e) reads: "Pharmacists may administer drugs in accordance with 21 NCAC 46 .2507." Based on adoption of permanent rule 21 NCAC 46 .2514, the Board of Nursing rule needs to be amended to include the new reference.
