Explain: COVID-19 Drug Preservation Rule: On March 10, 2020, the Governor of North Carolina, by issuing Executive Order No. 116, declared a state of emergency to coordinate a response and enact protective measures to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. COVID-19 is respiratory disease that can result in serious illness or death. COVID-19, previously unidentified in humans, spreads easily from person to person. Once an outbreak of COVID-19 begins, it is difficult to contain. The World Health Organization, the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, and the United States Department of Health and Human Services have declared COVID-19 a public health threat and emergency. The search for potential treatments for COVID-19 has caused shortages and threatens to cause further shortages in certain drugs. On March 24, 2020, the North Carolina State Health Director requested that the Medical Board, the Board of Nursing and the Board of Pharmacy adopt the COVID-19 Drug Preservation Rule in order to alleviate shortages and ensure that these drugs are available to patients who need them. This rule was adopted as an emergency and then a temporary rule. The State Health Director has requested that the rule be adopted as a permanent rule because the state of emergency and corresponding potential drug shortages now may potentially extend beyond the expiration of the temporary rule. The Board intends to repeal the rule upon the conclusion of the state of emergency. The State Health Director has determined that the State is unlikely to suffer future shortages of two of the drugs previously listed in the temporary and emergency rule, and that those drugs may be removed from the list, while the others should remain. Note: The underlined and struck through text are changes from the temporary rule currently in effect, to the proposed permanent rule.
