Because compensatory time cannot be cashed out or transferred to any other type of leave, there seems to be little reason to not allow transferring employees and the agencies receiving them to keep the employees' compensatory leave balances. In proposed 25 NCAC 01E .1006(4), the phrase that currently prohibits transferring compensatory time between agencies would be removed.

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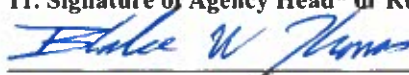
