Please fix the formatting of your History Note, specifically, the spacing. Also, delete the last period after "May 25, 2019", replace it with a semicolon, and add: "Temp. Amendment Eff. February 15, 2022."

2 (a) Every person employed as a correctional officer or probation/parole officer by the North Carolina Department of

- 3 Public Safety, Division of Adult Correction and Juvenile Justice shall have been examined and certified within one
- 4 year prior to employment with the North Carolina Department of Public Safety, Division of Adult Correction and
- 5 Juvenile Justice by a physician licensed in North Carolina, physician's assistant, or nurse practitioner to meet the
- 6 physical requirements to fulfill the officer's particular responsibilities as stated in the essential job functions.
- 7 (b) Every person employed as a correctional officer or probation/parole officer by the North Carolina Department of
- 8 Public Safety, Division of Adult Correction and Juvenile Justice shall have been administered within one year prior
- 9 to employment with the North Carolina Department of Public Safety, Division of Adult Correction and Juvenile Justice
- 10 a psychological screening examination by a clinical psychologist or psychiatrist licensed to practice in North Carolina
- 11 to determine the officer's mental and emotional suitability to fulfill the officer's particular responsibilities as stated in
- 12 the essential job functions a psychological screening examination in accordance with G.S. 17C-10(c). The
- 13 psychological screening shall be valid for a period of one year [prior to the criminal justice officer's initial appointment
- 14 and applies to any criminal justice officer seeking initial or probationary certification from the date on which it was
- 15 <u>administered.</u>
