## **REQUEST FOR § 150B-21.10 CHANGES**

AGENCY: Alarm Systems Licensing Board

The Rules Review Commission staff has completed its review of this Rule prior to the Commission's next meeting. The Commission has not yet reviewed this Rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the Rule will be approved. You may email the reviewing attorney to inquire concerning the staff recommendation.

In reviewing this Rule, the staff recommends the following changes be made:

On the "Submission for Permanent Rule" form, license is misspelled in Box 9B, within the parenthetical.

In Paragraph (a) and (b), "This online application shall be submitted not less than 30 days prior to expiration of the applicant's current license..." and "Applications for renewal shall be submitted not less than 30 days before the expiration date of the license." are stated. This requirement should only be stated once.

In Paragraph (d), the last sentence should state, in part, "compliance with State law and the Rules of this Chapter during the period of lapse.

In Paragraph (e), the second sentence should be clarified with language such as "All recommendations of denial..." instead of "All denials".

In Paragraph (f), the final sentence should be written in an active voice: "The licensee shall provide to the Board a copy of the military order or the extension approval of the...".

In the History Note: Authority, 74D-2(a) should not be limited to (a). Delete the (a). Also, "74D-2.1; 74D-5.1; 74D-6;" should be included, and then the list should be appropriately arranged numerically.

Please retype the rule accordingly and resubmit it to our office electronically.

14B NCAC 17 .0204 is proposed for amendment as published in 36:19 NCR 1556 as follows:

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## 14B NCAC 17.0204 RENEWAL OR REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

- 4 (a) Each applicant for a license renewal shall submit an online renewal application on the website provided by the Board. This online application shall be submitted not less than 30 days prior to expiration of the applicant's current license and shall be accompanied by:
  - (1) statements of the result of a local statewide criminal history records search by the reporting services service designated by the Board pursuant to G.S. 74D-2.1 for any state where the applicant has resided within the preceding preceding 24 months;
    - (2) the applicant's renewal fee as set forth in .0203(a)(2); and
  - (3) proof of liability insurance pursuant to G.S. 74D-9.
- 12 (b) Applications for renewal shall be submitted not less than 30 days before the expiration date of the license. No 13 renewal shall be granted more than 90 days after the date of expiration of a license.
- (c) Applications for renewal submitted after the expiration date of the license shall be accompanied by the late renewal fee established by Rule .0203 of this Section and shall be submitted not later than 90 days after the expiration date of the license.
- (d) If a licensee has maintained a license at least two years and <u>fails to renew the license within 90 days of the</u>
  expiration date, then allows the license to expire, the license may be re-issued if <u>an online reinstatement application</u>
  is <u>made submitted</u> within one year of the expiration date. <u>The reinstatement application must include accompanied by</u>
  the items required in Subparagraphs (a)(1) through (3) of this Rule, the late fee required by Paragraph (c) of this Rule,
  evidence of compliance with the electrical licensing requirements of Rule .0210 of this Section, and documentation
  of completion within the previous two years of continuing education as required by Section .0500 of this Chapter. If
  the license reinstatement is approved, the license period shall be prorated to expire on the date the previous license
- 24 <u>would have expired, had the license been renewed on time.</u> The licensee shall remain responsible for compliance with
- 25 the Board's law and administrative rules during the period of lapse.
- 26 (e) The Director shall review and approve or recommend denial of an application for renewal or reinstatement. All 27 denials shall be submitted to the Board for a final Board decision.
- 28 (f) Members of the armed forces whose licenses are in good standing and to whom G.S. 105-249.2 grants an extension 29 of time to file a tax return shall be granted the same extension of time to pay the license renewal fee and to complete 30 the continuing education requirements prescribed in Section .0500 of this Chapter. A copy of the military order or the 31 extension approval by the Internal Revenue Service or by the North Carolina Department of Revenue shall be

32 furnished to the Board.
