## Regarding 21 NCAC 05 .0201 APPLICATION FOR LICENSURE OF LICENSED BEHAVIOR ANALYST 4 AND LICENSED ASSISTANT BEHAVIOR ANALYST

• We recommend that a more definitive timeline for application submission and board consideration be included in the rules. Ideally, applications would be due on a particular day of the month, and then board meetings would be appropriately scheduled to consider those applications before the month-end.
