Thanks for making the changes. The rule looks good, I just have a few things that I think need to be resolved. See below.

Paragraph (c), line 13, and (e), line 19, how does the applicant demonstrate that he or she continues to qualify for a provisional license? Is it just that they must meet the criteria in G.S. 90D-8? Please clarify.

Yes, the applicant just has to meet the requirements listed in G.S. 90D-8 when requesting an extension of the provisional license.

Thanks for the clarification. I would add a reference here, something along the lines of "...the applicant continues to qualify for a provisional license, license, by meeting the requirements of G.S. 90D-8."

In (d), line 16, is "the license being renewed" only applicable to "provisional licenses" or does this apply to all licenses?

This is only applicable to provisional licenses.

As you use "provisional license" everywhere else in the rule, I would change (d) to say "provisional license" in both instances as well.

How does (f) affect the Board's ability to extend a deadline for filing a license renewal under (h)? If (h) is indeed is intended as an exception, you may want to add to (f) language like "With the exception of servicemembers who qualify for an extension under Paragraph (h) of this Rule..." or something similar.

This language was added to (f) as suggested.

Great, thanks for taking my suggestion. I would put "With" into lowercase, though.

In your History Note, is G.S. 90D-12 necessary as authority for this Rule? What disciplinary action is being taken here?

The history note was not altered for the submission. If the history note for 90D-12 should be removed we can make that change.

It's your rule, I do not know if it needs to be removed or not. It just appears to me that 90D-12 refers to disciplinary action, and this Rule does not. I think you should consult with your counsel and determine if there's a reason for the reference to 90D-12 being here. If so, let me know. If not, take it out.

Also, I think the deletion from line 29 to line 33 was in the original published text, so it shouldn't be highlighted. Just FYI.

If these changes are made, I will be able to recommend approval of the rule at this month's meeting.

Paragraph (c), line 13, and (e), line 19, how does the applicant demonstrate that he or she continues to qualify for a provisional license? Is it just that they must meet the criteria in G.S. 90D-8? Please clarify.

Yes, the applicant just has to meet the requirements listed in G.S. 90D-8 when requesting an extension of the provisional license.

In (d), line 16, is "the license being renewed" only applicable to "provisional licenses" or does this apply to all licenses?

This is only applicable to provisional licenses.

Also, in (d), what is a "renewal license"? Perhaps you meant "renewed license"?

In (e), line 21, delete the comma following "applicant".

In (e)(4), because you changed the punctuation following "extension" you need to reflect that change like this: "extension extension."

In (g), what is an "initial provisional license"?

The initial provisional license is the first provisional license that is issued after successful application for the provisional license.
