Additionally, Nurse Practitioners in North Carolina are required to have more continuing education than any other licensed healthcare professional in this state. The clinical pharmacist is the next closest in requiring 35 hours annually. The proposed amendment would require 50 contact hours of continuing education every 2 years as opposed to every year.
