History Note, is your agency relying on G.S. 87-4 to promulgate this Rule (i.e. "rules and regulations as it shall deem best, provided the same are not in conflict with the laws of North Carolina")? If so, has an analysis been conducted to ensure this Rule is not in conflict with the laws of N.C.?

PROPOSED RESPONSE:

N.C. Gen. Stat. 87-4 gives the Board the authority to promulgate rules "as [the Board shall] deem best, provided the same are not in conflict with the laws of North Carolina." Prior to adopting this amendment, Board Counsel reviewed relevant statutes and is unaware of any conflict with the laws of North Carolina.
