9 associations, and corporations engaged in providing ~~alarm~~ security systems and services to citizens of North Carolina.

1 14B NCAC 17 .0504 is proposed for amendment as published in 40:21 NCR 1658 as follows:

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3 **14B NCAC 17 .0504 NON-RESIDENT LICENSEE OR REGISTRANT CONTINUING EDUCATION**
4 **CREDITS**

5 A non-resident licensee or registrant shall obtain the required continuing education credits as set forth in Rule .0502
6 of this Section. If a non-resident licensee or registrant resides in a state that requires continuing education for ~~an alarm~~
7 a security systems business license, then the continuing education courses to be offered in the state of residence may
8 be considered by the North Carolina Security Systems Licensing Board for sanctioning in North Carolina on an
9 individual course basis. In determining if the course is to be sanctioned, the Board shall review the course to determine
10 if the course is pertinent to the industry and if the course meets its stated objective.
