Form 400-Box 6 you provide a link to the agency's notice, but it directs to a 404-Page not Found error. You did not check the box indicating that requirements were listed on the website in compliance with G.S. 150B-19.1(c)(1)-(5). A search of your website did not locate any information about pending rules. Please provide proof that the necessary notice was given.

The wrong version of this Rule was used both here and when you published in the register. The Rule was amended effective March 1, 2026 to change "Alarm" to "Security" which could be done under G.S. 150B-21.5(a)(2) without submission to the Commission.

Line 3 and 7 the word Security is already in the current rule

Line 11 Authority 74D-4 is a correct authority. However, 74D-5 lays out the Boards functions of administering licenses and setting educational and training requirements, should it be included as well?

Line 17, History Note, edit the line to read "Amended Eff. October 1, 2026; March 1, 2026."

3 **14B NCAC 17 .0504 NON-RESIDENT LICENSEE OR REGISTRANT CONTINUING EDUCATION**
4 **CREDITS**

5 A non-resident licensee or registrant shall obtain the required continuing education credits as set forth in Rule .0502
6 of this Section. If a non-resident licensee or registrant resides in a state that requires continuing education for ~~an alarm~~
7 a security systems business license, then the continuing education courses to be offered in the state of residence may
8 be considered by the North Carolina Security Systems Licensing Board for sanctioning in North Carolina on an
9 individual course basis. In determining if the course is to be sanctioned, the Board shall review the course to determine
10 if the course is pertinent to the industry and if the course meets its stated objective.
