Jeff,

Thank you for responding to my request for changes. I have reviewed all of the attachments you sent as well as the updated rules. Thank you for updating the history notes and providing background as to why the versions of the rule may have differed. Please note going forward that the best approach to avoid any issues with versions is to always utilize the most current rule published in the Code when submitting to the RRC. Thankfully, the differences between what was currently in the code and what was used were clearly very minor, so they are not substantial differences.

The one concern I still have going forward is regarding notice. Because the box indicating that the requirements of G.S. 150B-19.1(c)(1)-(5) was met was not checked for either .0101 or .0504, I need clear evidence of compliance to ensure no need for objections under G.S. 150B-21.9(a)(4). I reviewed the emails you provided between Paul Sherwin and Laura Hourigan. It is clear that Paul sent a message requesting a document entitled "Notice to Amend Rules .0101, .0504, and repeal .0401.pdf" be used to replace a different document on April 23, 2026. Laura responded that it had been "updated." Then on July 6, 2026, Paul sent another message requesting that Laura do something with the same document. What he wanted her to do was unclear, but she replied that she "made this edit." Based on these emails I cannot determine whether the information in the document complies with GS 150B-19.1(c)(1) or (2) because the contents are not provided. Additionally, none of the emails are actual evidence that the references made to replacing a document meant that they were posted on the public facing website. Please provide evidence of the actual language and its presence on the Board's website.

As long as there is evidence of notice to comply with GS 150B-19.1(c)(1)-(5), I have no other concerns about the language within the rule. Please provide a response no later than 9am on Tuesday September 22nd. Thank you.

Below and attached are my responses to your questions and Request for Changes.

Both 14B NCAC 17 .0101 & .0504:

Once the date of the Public Comment Period has passed, the Board's Director instructs DPS's Communications Officer to remove the post. Attached are the various e-mail exchanges requesting that the notice be posted initially and that it be taken down.

Both 14B NCAC 17 .0101 & .0504 (.0101, generally, and Line 3 and Line 7; .0504, Line 8.)

Thank you for your observation that these changes could have been made under G.S. 150B-21.5(a)(2). I agree with you. However, the Codifier of Rules disagrees. Please see the e-mail exchange between he and I, attached. His instructions to me are the only reason these two rules are before you. Also, as to using the wrong rule(s), please see the e-mail exchange between Julie Eddins & Serena Samuels and me regarding this issue or question. Since I was told it could not be changed without going through the rulemaking process, I used an "original" version of the rule. But again, I appreciate you pointing it out.

Both 14 B NCAC 17 .0101 & .0504 (.0101, History Note, Line 17; .0504, History Note, Line 16.)

In light of the above explanation, it would not have been accurate for me to state at the time that it was amended effective March 1, 2026, however I have now added it. *See*, attached.

14B NCAC 17 .0101:

History Note, Line 11. I have added G.S. 74D-5. *See*, attached.

14B NCAC 17 .0504:

Line 5. The plain meaning of the word is the intent. It is a person who is not a resident of North Carolina. This is clearly determinable by the address used on the application. No definition is necessary.

Lines 9 & 10. The Board considers exactly what the rule says, whether it is pertinent to the industry and whether it meets the course objectives. Both things are determined by reviewing the course materials, which include the objectives for comparison. If the course is about how to bake a pound cake but does not have the ingredients, it is neither pertinent to the industry, nor meeting the course objectives.

Sorry for the delay, I was a little under the weather last week. Hope you both had a nice weekend!

I can approve the changes to rules .0102, .0401, and .0503. They'll be entered into the Code with a March 1, 2026 effective date.

Unfortunately, in rule .0101, line 9, and rule .0504, line 7, the change from "alarm" to "security" falls outside the name of your organization. Those changes, although simple, have to go through rulemaking, as they fall outside the scope of my authority under G.S. 150B-21.5.

Please resubmit Rules .0101 and .0504 with just the change to the name of the organization, and I will approve them and get them in the Code with the others. As long as they are refiled before the end of the week, they'll carry a March 1 effective date with the other rules.

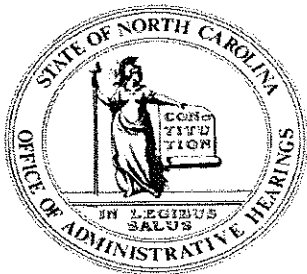
