- Once comments are received and reviewed, the NCMB may make revisions to the rule based on feedback. The rule is then submitted to the NC Rules Review Commission for final approval (Status = Submitted to RRC)
- If the rule is approved by RRC, the status will be updated to indicate "Approved."
