
Areas Subject to Harvest Reporting

This map was produced to highlight the major waterbodies where reporting will be required. Some smaller waters impacted by the requirement may not be shown in this map due to graphical limitations. Please see below.

15A NCAC 03I .0123

- I think your agency needs to define "permanent possession" in the Rule (e.g., when an individual stops fishing and decides to keep the fish). I suggest using "permanent personal possession" in the definition of "harvest" or specify who will have possession when defining "permanent possession" in the Rule (e.g. "when an angler stops fishing and decides to keep the fish"). Who reduces the fish to permanent possession is important to determine for compliance with 15A NCAC 03I .0124(b).
- In (a)(1), change the second "the" to "any" shore.
- In (a)(2), please cite or cross reference the definitions of "use" and "gear" in 15A NCAC 03I .0101.
- In (b) lines 12-13, is "in accordance with Paragraph (a) of this Rule" necessary to include?
- In (b) lines 13-14, please add a comma after "dealer" and after "Section".

The requests and questions above also apply to 15A NCAC 03I 0124.

The Rules Review Commission staff has completed its review of this Rule prior to the Commission's next meeting. The Commission has not yet reviewed this Rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the Rule will be approved. You may email the reviewing attorney to inquire concerning the staff recommendation.

In reviewing this Rule, the staff recommends the following changes be made:

In line 4, replace "Pursuant to" with "Under" for clarity. "Under" is more accurate since "harvest" is not defined in G.S. 113-170.3.

Completed

In line 5, will the phrase "reduction of such fish to possession" be clear to your regulated public? Who will have "possession" of the fish once they're reduced? The vessel's captain, first mate, deckhands, or anglers may all be involved in catching fish.

The text has been amended to change "reduction of such fish to possession" to "reducing it to permanent possession" as found in the WRC's rule (see line 11 in 15A NCAC 10C .0218).

In (a)(1), should "the" shore be changed to "any" shore?

Completed

In (a)(2), the phrase "at the moment a person is no longer engaged in fishing" seems amorphous. What if someone catches a fish, stops briefly, then resumes fishing? When is the "harvest" complete for the caught fish? The timing of when the harvest is complete is important for compliance with subsection (b) of this Rule.

The text has been amended to change "at the moment a person is no longer engaged in fishing" to "when the person's fishing gear is stowed and no longer in use." The MFC defines "use" in 15A NCAC 03I .0101.

In (b) line 9, to whom and how shall the harvest be reported? Also, please delete the comma after "complete."

The phrase "to a fish dealer licensed under G.S. 113-169.3" has been added on line 12. A person subject to the requirements in Paragraph (b) shall report their harvest to a

fish dealer, who in turn records the harvest as set out in Subparagraphs (b)(1) and (b)(2), so "how" the person reports is by providing information to the fish dealer, which has been clarified in lines 13-14. The comma after "complete" has been retained due to the other amendments that were needed to address the request.

In (b)(1), I don't see any "reporting" requirements in G.S. 113-168.2. I only see "recording" requirements in subsection (i). Please confirm if your citation is accurate.

The citation is accurate. In lines 15 and 17, "reporting requirements" has been changed to "recording requirements".

In line 12, should the "and" after the semicolon be changed to "or"?

The conjunction "and" is correct. Both fish that are sold and fish harvested but not sold shall be reported.

In (b)(2) line 14, is there a reason to use the language "in the same manner as provided...for a transaction" instead of "in Rule .0114 of this Section" as was done in subsection (1)? Is there a distinction that makes it necessary to use different language?

Yes, there is a distinction. The requirements under G.S. 113-168.2 and 15A NCAC 03I .0114 currently apply only to fish sold to a fish dealer. Fish harvested but not sold are required to be reported, but the mechanism was not specified in the session law. Rather than creating a duplicative reporting system, this rule requires commercial fishers to use the existing "trip ticket" system that otherwise would only apply to fish that are sold. The distinct language in subsection (2) was deliberate in order to require the use of the same method even though the referenced statute and rule only refer to fish that are sold.

The Rules Review Commission staff has completed its review of this Rule prior to the Commission's next meeting. The Commission has not yet reviewed this Rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the Rule will be approved. In reviewing this Rule, the staff recommends the following changes be made:

In line 4, replace "Pursuant to" with "Under" for clarity. "Under" is more accurate since "harvest" is not defined in G.S. 113-170.3.

Completed

In line 5, will the phrase "reduction of such fish to possession" be clear to your regulated public? Who will have "possession" of the fish once they're reduced? The vessel's captain, first mate, deckhands, or anglers may all be involved in catching fish.

The text has been amended to change "reduction of such fish to possession" to "reducing it to permanent possession" as found in the WRC's rule (see line 11 in 15A NCAC 10C .0218).

In (a)(1), should "the" shore be changed to "any" shore?

Completed

In (a)(2), the phrase "at the moment a person is no longer engaged in fishing" seems amorphous. What if someone catches a fish, stops briefly, then resumes fishing? When is the harvest "complete" for the caught fish? The timing of when the harvest is complete is important for compliance with subsection (b) of this Rule.

The text has been amended to change "at the moment a person is no longer engaged in fishing" to "when the person's fishing gear is stowed and no longer in use." The MFC defines "use" in 15A NCAC 03I .0101.

In (b) line 9, please add ",as defined in 15A NCAC 03I .0123(a)," after "harvest."

The harvest referenced in line 9 is defined in Paragraph (a) of 03I .0124, so this clarification has been added to the text. (The same clarification was made in 03I .0123, pointing to Paragraph (a) of 03I .0123.)

In line 10, add an "s" to "Harvest."

Making this plural would be inconsistent with numerous other MFC rules that refer to "harvest" singularly and would be confusing to stakeholders, so the text was left intact.

In (b) lines 10-11, is there another MFC rule related to the electronic reporting of harvests? Is "required by the Division of Marine Fisheries" necessary to include? The public already knows this since your agency has adopted this Rule.

The text has been simplified by striking "by either electronic reporting means required by the Division of Marine Fisheries" and adding "by using" so the sentence reads: "Harvest shall be reported by either electronic reporting means required by the Division of Marine Fisheries online at https://www.ncmarinefisheries.net, or by using a Division-issued report card."

In line 11, does your agency characterize the "Division-issued report card" as a "form" under G.S. 150B-2(8d)? Are the contents of the "report card" described in another Rule or in a statute?

No. The text has been clarified to show the report card is simply the paper version of what is required to be reported online, to increase accessibility to reporting mechanisms for regulated stakeholders. The harvest data to be reported online and by using the report card are listed in Subparagraphs (b)(1) through (b)(7) of this Rule.

In lines 11-12, add "in accordance with 15A NCAC 03I .0123" after "complete."

The phrase "in accordance with Paragraph (a) of this Rule" has been added after "complete". (Reference to 15A NCAC 03I .0123 would connect the requirements of this non-commercial rule with the commercial rule. The same type of clarification was made to 03I .0123, also referring to paragraph (a) of that rule.)

In line 13, consider replacing the comma after "complete" with a period. Delete "except" and start the sentence with "When".

In (b)(1) line 16, please spell out "N.C.".

Completed

In (b)(1), is the "person" referred to the individual who harvested the fish? Please make this clear for the regulated public.

In line 17, add "the zip code of their **primary** residence" after "and".
