

RULES REVIEW COMMISSION MEETING
MINUTES
August 27, 2026

The Rules Review Commission met on Thursday, August 27, 2026, in the Commission Room at 1711 New Hope Church Road, Raleigh, North Carolina, and the meeting was streamed for the public via Webex.

Commissioners Wesley Jones, John Hahn, Jeff Hyde, Bill Nelson, Jake Parker, and Paul Powell were present in the Commission Room.

Staff members Alexander Burgos, Commission Counsel Seth Ascher, Meghan Barney, Travis Wiggs, and Christopher Miller were present in the room.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. with Chair Parker presiding.

The Chair read the notice required by G.S. 138A-15(e) and reminded the Commission members that they have a duty to avoid conflicts of interest and the appearance of conflicts of interest.

Chair Parker entered into the record that Commissioner Overton was administered his Oath of Office for his reappointment by a notary public prior to the meeting.

Chair Parker introduced Chris Dillon, Chief Judge of the North Carolina Court of Appeals, to the Commission.

Chief Judge Dillon administered the Oath of Office to newly appointed Commissioner Wesley B. Jones, and reappointed Commissioner Paul Powell.

The Chair read into the record the biennial evaluation of statements of economic interest from the State Ethics Commission as follows:

Wesley B. Jones is an associate attorney with the law firm Chalmers, Adams, Backer & Wallen PLLC. In addition, he owns Wes Jones Consulting & Law. Because these entities could represent clients that come before the Commission during the rulemaking process, he has the potential for a conflict of interest. As such, Mr. Jones should exercise appropriate caution in the performance of his public duties should the business of the law firm Chalmers, Adams, Backer & Wallen PLLC, Wes Jones Consulting & Law, or their clients come before the Commission for official action.

Wayne R. Boyles, III is the President of Milvian Bridge Government and Public Affairs, LLC. As such, he has the potential for a conflict of interest and should exercise appropriate caution in the performance of his public duties should an issue involving Milvian Bridge Government and Public Affairs, LLC or its clients come before the Commission for official action.

John Hahn is the owner and manager of John S. Hahn PLLC. In addition, he receives professional fees from the law firm Mayer Brown LLP which could represent clients that come before the Commission during the rulemaking process. As such, Mr. Hahn has the potential for a conflict of interest and should exercise appropriate caution in the performance of his public duties should an issue involving his clients, the law firm of Mayer Brown LLP, or their clients come before the Commission for official action.

Bill Nelson is a partner with the law firm Smith Anderson. Because the law firm could represent clients that come before the Commission during the rulemaking process, he has the potential for a conflict of

interest. In addition, his spouse is an Administrative Law Judge at the N.C. Office of Administrative Hearings. As such, Mr. Nelson should exercise appropriate caution in the performance of his public duties should an issue involving the law firm Smith Anderson, their clients, or an issue that involves his spouse's role as an NC OAH Administrative Judge, come before the Commission for official action.

Wyatt Dixon, III is the founding partner of the real estate investment and development firm Proffitt Dixon Partners. In addition, he is a board member of the Charlotte Metro Transit Authority. Mr. Dixon has financial interests in several publicly and non-publicly owned companies and businesses. As such, he has the potential for a conflict of interest and should exercise appropriate caution in the performance of his public duties should an issue involving Proffitt Dixon Partners or any entity in which he has a financial interest or with which he is associated come before the Commission for official action.

Paul Powell disclosed that he is retired and no longer works for RH Barringer Dist. Co. He has a financial interest in Carolina Select Fine Wines LLC. Because the Alcohol Beverage Control Commission could present rules for review by the Commission, he has the potential for a conflict of interest. In addition, he serves on the Mars Hill University Board of Trustees. As such, Mr. Powell should exercise appropriate caution in the performance of his public duties should an issue involving Carolina Select Fine Wines LLC or any entity with which he is associated come before the Commission for official action.

Jake Parker is the Secretary and General Counsel for the North Carolina Farm Bureau Federation, Inc. In addition, he is their registered lobbyist. As such, Mr. Parker has the potential for a conflict of interest and should exercise appropriate caution in the performance of his public duties should an issue involving the North Carolina Farm Bureau Federation, Inc., or any other entity with which he may be associated come before the Commission for official action.

The Chair notified the Commission that the following agenda items will be taken up at the end of the meeting: Follow-up matters Tabs 1 and 2 for Child Care Commission, Tab 3 for Mining Commission, and Permanent Rules for the State Board of Elections.
