Dear Mr. Blue:

At its meeting this morning, the Rules Review Commission declined to approve the above-captioned temporary rules in accordance with G.S. 150B-21.1(b).

The Rules Review Commission found the Criminal Justice Education and Training Standards Commission (CJETS) did not meet the requirements for temporary rules as set forth in G.S. 150B-21.1(a)(1). Specifically, the Commission found that CJETS had not shown that COVID was “unforeseen” at this time, which is required by that subsection in order to engage in temporary rulemaking.
