Paraoptometric personnel who 7 wish or need to become certified as optometric assistants or optometric technicians must be certified by the American 8 Optometric Association and maintain such certification. 9 (b) Paraoptometric personnel shall perform his or her functions within the scope of his or her training, as directed by 10 and assigned by an optometrist, so long as those functions are at the specific direction and under the supervision of 11 the licensee.
