2 3 21 NCAC 42B .0204 **CEASING PRACTICE** 4 (a) In the event an optometrist shall cease to practice at any practice location (primary or branch) as defined in Rules 5 .0201 and .0202 of this Section, the optometrist shall notify the Board in writing within ten days of ceasing practice, 6 indicating the reason for discontinuing practice and the disposition of patient records. 7 (b) In the event that a licensee discontinues practice at a location for which a duplicate license has been issued, the 8 licensee shall return the license to the Board for cancellation within 30 days. 9 (e) (b) On ceasing practice at any location, the licensee shall notify those patients whose records he retains in 10 accordance with 21 NCAC 42E .0102(5) and (6) of the disposition or availability of such records. Such notice shall 11 be given by direct mail mail, email, or through a public announcement in a newspaper of general circulation in the 12 county or counties wherein the patients reside. If such notice is given by publication, such publication shall occur not 13 less than weekly for a period of not less than ninety days. Proof of the giving of such notice shall be retained by the 14 licensee. 15 (d) (c) Any licensee ceasing practice shall maintain control and custody of the records located at that practice location 16 until such time as such records are transferred to the patients or to the custody of another practitioner similarly licensed. 17 (d) Should an optometrist pass away while in practice, the optometrist's estate shall comply with paragraph (b) above 18 and attempt to place any medical records for which no directions are received from the patient into the hands of an 19 optometrist or ophthalmologist located in proximity to the deceased optometrist's practice location as soon as possible. 20 Any records retained by the estate shall be maintained for the period of time required by 21 NCAC 42E .0102 (6). 21 22 History Note: Authority G.S. 90-117.5; 90-118.2; 23 Eff.
