Per Mr. Ascher's email below and the attached Request for Changes Pursuant to G.S. 150B-21.10, please see the North Carolina Occupational Safety and Health Review Commission's revised rule, attached.

We have one issue with a correction request. The Request for Changes memo said:

"On p.1, line 18, add a semi-colon after officer: "officer officer; or".

The term "bona fide full-time" (p.1, line 17) modifies both "officer" and "employee". Inserting a semicolon after officer would imply that "bona fide full-time" does not also apply to the type of employee who is allowed to be an authorized representative. The employee must be "bona fide full-time" as well.

I added a semi-colon between "entity" and "and" (p. 1, line 19) to separate the third and final example in the list of those who are allowed be an authorized representative.
