Please accept this correspondence as the North Carolina Sheriffs' Education and Training Standards Commission's response to the September 25, 2024 letter setting forth the Rules Review Commission's objection to rule 12 NCAC 10B .1302 finding that the rule did not satisfy G.S. 150B-21.9(a)(4). To satisfy the objection per G.S.150B-21.12(a)(1), the Commission met on October 2, 2024 and adopted rule 12 NCAC 10B .1302 with a new effective date and voted to accept the same technical change we made to rule 12 NCAC 10B .0601(c) to satisfy a comment staff counsel made to that rule. The Commission's rulemaking coordinator, Melissa Bowman submitted this rule to the Rules Review Commission today, within the 30 day time requirement for submission. See attached for a copy of the submitted revised rule.
