Jeff,

A commissioner raised a clarity concern I want to bring to your attention.

In rule 14B NCAC 17 .0201 on line 7 and in rule 14B NCAC 17 .0301 on line 7, you list "(2) gender, race, and military service". The concern is that some applicants will not have served in the military and it won't be clear how to complete the form.

You could clarify this by adding "any" before military service or "if applicable" after. It might also be cleaner if you broke "military service" into a separate bullet.

Practically, if you want to update the rules before the meeting, please get them to today. Alternatively, if you want to address this at the Commission meeting tomorrow and the Commission as a whole has concerns, we can handle this via an "approval contingent on a technical change".

I am responding to your Request for Changes:

14B NCAC 17 .0201

Requested change made.

Also, I am very familiar with *Devalle*. The Board's "good moral character" standard is defined by statute in G.S. 74D-2(d)(2) and G.S. 74D-(6)(3) by equating the conduct to conviction of a broad category of state and federal crimes. This Board, the Private Protective Services Board, and one other board are the only three boards in NC with this detailed definition. I am confident it meets the new standard established by *Devalle*.

14B NCAC 17 .0202

The Board is not incorporating the course standards, or any material, by reference for either course. It is merely stating that course completion suffices for the training requirement. This language was approved by the RRC in January 2024.

14B NCAC 17 .0209

(Same as .0201, above.)

14B NCAC 17 .0210

I confirmed with the Board of Electrical Contractors that the current designation is "SP-FA/LV." Suggested change made.

14B NCAC 17 .0301

Requested change made. The reference in old (b), i.e. new "(c)," is to the application form in (a). It is not a second or separate form.

14B NCAC 17 .0305

Yes, the duties of an employee are spelled out in detail in G.S. 74D-8(a)(1), entitled “Registration of persons employed.”
